Wednesday - the younger grades were off to Jump and Jacks!!

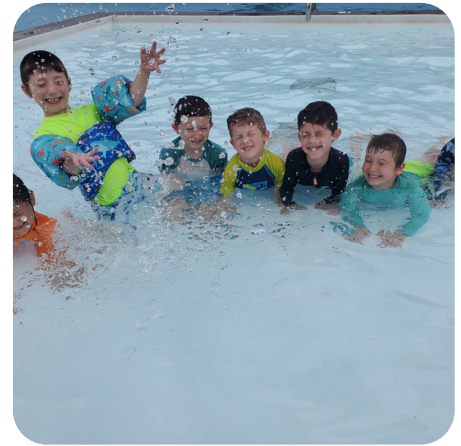
Climbing....jumping....sliding and racing!
